Death mask. A traditional visage utilized post-funeral. Grasped by the handle beneath the chin, it may be intermittently taken off and put back in place in front of the performer's head, veiled in raffia and adorned with kaolin.

Height: 33 centimeters

Face with a strong initiation power. Exclusively utilized in the forest and at night, under the full moon at the center of 4 fires lit successively by the carrier of this spirit.

Height: 40 centimeters

Region: situated between KASAĪ and URUA, the diviner bears scarifications on his body that symbolize his role as the protector of traditional practices among upcoming initiates. Noteworthy is the headdress resembling the Bakuba lace and Hebrew kipa, along with the double-headed serpent on his back symbolizing the balance between good and evil forces.

Talisman worn on the belt for protection against hunger and to bring good fortune while hunting.

Box statue positioned next to the crib to provide guidance during sleep.
